

· Journey on a train through the mines • Visit of the underground galleries (more than 80 meters below the surface)

The tour starts aboard a mine train which first takes you through old opencast mines and then enters the underground mine through the Langengrund tunnel. The largest part of the collection is on display in the mine's original tunnels. Presented in their original location, the machinery and tools are a vivid reminder of mining as it was. This exhibition gives the visitor a real understanding of working in a mine and reveals more than a century of technological evolution.


The Documentation Center presents the fascinating history of the inhabitants of the "Italie" district as part of a "museum without walls".
